Jeane graduated from Shenandoah High School with the class of 1940. After graduation she attended the American Institute of Business in Des Moines, IA.

Jeane resided in Shenandoah, IA until she married Nathan Otis 'Mac' McCrary Jr. August 6, 1944. After marriage moved to Ames, IA, then to Kansas City, MO where Mac attended the Kansas City School of Watchmaking. Jeane and Mac opened their first jewelry store in O'Neil, NE; later returned to Southwest Iowa in 1949 setting in Red Oak opening McCrary Jewelry Store. In 1963 Mac and Jeane returned to Ames. Jeane was a member of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary and member of the Daughters of the American Revolution. She attended the First Presbyterian Church of Shenandoah.

Jeane was an avid embroiderer and dabbled in knitting, sewing and stained glass making.

She is preceded in death by her parents Jay and Ferne Bortland. Her husband Nathan Otis McCrary Jr. and grandson Ryan J. McCrary of Grosse Pointe Park, MI.
