Sec. 2347. RECORD OF BURIALS TO BE KEPT. The record-keeping officer of every cemetery shall make and keep a permanent record of all burials, disposals, disinterments, or reburials made in such cemetery, which record shall at all times be open to public inspection. This record shall, in each case, state the name of each deceased person, place of death, date of burial, disposal, disinterment or reburial, and name and address of the undertaker.
