

Dollie Belle Boone was born March 21, 1905 in Chillicothe, Missouri to Harrison and Mary Alice (Bennett) Watson. She passed away at the age of 97 on November 8, 2002 at the Afton Care Center in Afton, Iowa. She graduated from Shenandoah High School and Central Bible College in Springfield, Mo. On December 24, 1925 she married Gordon Boone in Sidney, Iowa. They lived in Shenandoah and Red Oak for many years. Dollie worked in Shenandoah as an office manager for the local laundry and cleaning company. She and Gordon sang with parents of the Everly Brothers on KMA Radio on Sunday afternoons. In Red Oak, she worked for the Thomas D. Murphy Company, producing artistic calendars. She and her husband Rev. H. G. Boone, also ministered at their own church. Gordon passed away on December 24, 1977, after 52 years of marriage. She moved to Afton, Iowa in 1997. Her last years were spent in the Afton Care Center, where she received excellent care by the staff. Dollie was formerly an active member of her church. She is survived by one son: Darius (wife Elane) Boone of Afton; 2 grandchildren, Mindi (husband Chris) Eslinger of Theynor and Hank Boone of Ames; 1 great-granddaughter, Quinn Eslinger.
