Max Robert Currie, the son of George Washington and Galena E. (Lingo) Currie, was born November 5, 1913, in rural Essex Iowa, and passed away October 29, 2002, in Shenandoah, Iowa.

Max grew up in rural Essex and received his education from the Essex community schools where he graduated from high school. He also graduated from Lincoln Flying School in Lincoln, Nebraska. On April 28, 1935 Max was united in marriage to Dorothy D. Aldrich, and to this union John, Gene, George, Kenneth and Judith were born. He was employed by Lockheed Aircraft in Santa Monica, California before and during World War II. He then moved his family back to the Essex area where Max farmed until he retired in 1978.
