SEC. 587-a. SUPPLEMENT, 1915. It shall be the duty of the record-keeping officer of each cemetery to make and keep a permanent record of all interments made in such cemetery, which record shall at all times be open to public inspection. This record shall consist of a copy of the certificate of death as provided by the state board of health, and a record of the exact location of grave on cemetery lot. It shall be the duty of the attendant physician to furnish, and of the undertaker to procure from him a certificate of death before proceeding with the burial; and it shall be the duty of the undertaker to present to the sexton or other persons in charge of the cemetery at or before the time of interment, a copy of such death certificate.

These sheets to be used on the grounds to secure data which will be copied permanently in Cemetery Lot Record.

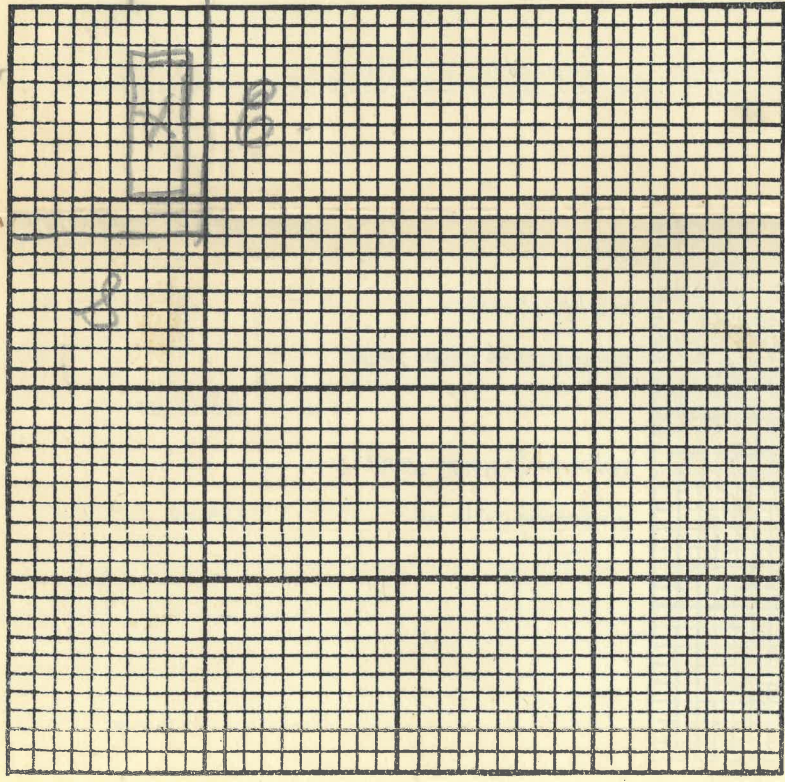
Note: Each small square represents a square foot of lot surface. For convenience each tenth foot is indicated by a heavy line. To make a record of previous burials, draw a diagram, with pencil, of each lot, beginning with Lot No. 1, and use a separate sheet for each lot. This can be done in the office from the plat and the owner's name and other data as to ownership secured from deed record. These blanks will then be taken to the cemetery and a record will be made from the lots, of the names of those buried and location of grave on lot. A number corresponding to name must be placed on plat to identify grave.
