**Cline Adwell**

Ernest Cline Adwell, the son of Ernest D. and Susie (Payne) Adwell, was born July 13, 1909, in Freedom, KY and departed this life on February 21, 2000, in Shenandoah, IA.

Cline, as he was commonly known, grew up in Barren County, KY and received his education from the Freedom, KY school system. Cline helped on the family farm from the time he was eight years old until moving to Shenandoah in March 1939. On August 17, 1939, he married Edith Williams and to this union five children, Suecilla, Carolann, Ernest, Jr., Mary Ruth and Martha Rose were born. Cline began working for Mount Arbor Nurseries in 1939. He was inducted into the army in 1943 and served until October 24, 1945. Upon his return from the service he returned to Mount Arbor Nurseries where he worked for 58 years. For 38 years he was a supervisor at a storage building which was named after him – the Cline Adwell Storage Building No. 1.

Preceding Cline in death were his parents, Ernest D. and Susie Adwell, two daughters, Mary Ruth and Martha Rose, three brothers, Clellan, Roy and Kiah Adwell and one sister, Buena Adwell.

Cline is survived by his wife, Edith, of Shenandoah; his son Ernest Adwell, Jr. of Kansas City, MO, daughter Suecilla Adwell of St. Joseph, MO daughter Carolann Adwell of Shenandoah, and a sister, Yema Harlow of Glasgow, KY.
