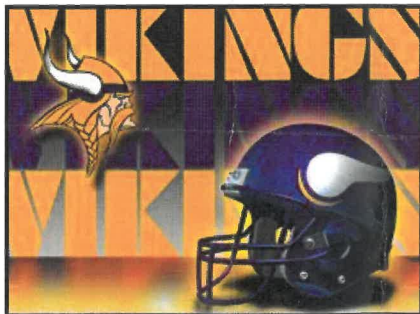

Isaac loved all things sports but especially his Shenandoah Mustangs team, the Minnesota Vikings and Missouri Tigers. He learned to drive the riding lawn mower at the age of two and from that point on he drove anything he could get his hands on from trucks to tractors to golf carts. But of all the things he enjoyed, he loved to fish the most. He packed a lot of “fish stories” into his short life.

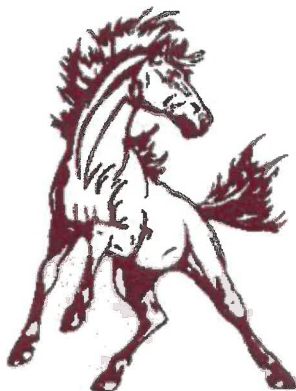

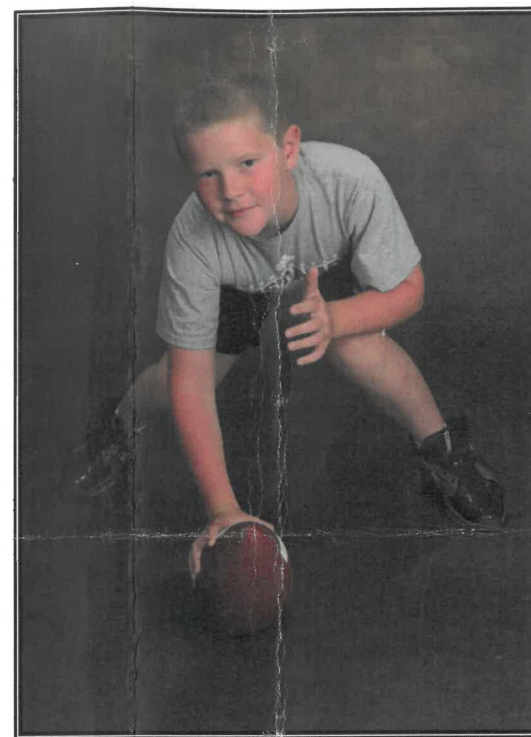
