Fred Lindburg, son of Arthur and Hilda Falk Lindburg, was born on April 18, 1916, in Essex, Iowa, and passed away at the Shenandoah Memorial Hospital on January 24, 2001. He was 84 years of age. He spent his early life in Essex and graduated from the Essex High School. He received a bachelor of arts degree from Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska, and also a J. D. degree from Creighton University. Fred served as a Tech. Sergeant in the Army during World War II, serving as a law advisor. On January 1, 1944, he was united in marriage with Elizabeth O'Hara. They made their home in Shenandoah for the 57 years of their married life. Fred, never retiring, was a practicing attorney in Shenandoah since World War II.
