Earnest Elmer Beck, son of Isaac and Georgia A. (Norris) Beck, was born February 26, 1918, at Essex, Iowa and passed away on April 10, 2000, at the Tabor Manor Care Center in Tabor, Iowa. He was 82 years of age.

Earnest grew up in the Essex and Shenandoah area. On July 2, 1943, during World War II, Earnest enlisted in the U. S. Air Force. He was honorably discharged from service on January 22, 1947.
