This record shall, in each case, state the name of each deceased person, place of death, date of burial, disposal, disinterment or reburial, and name and address of the undertaker.

This can be done in the office from the plat and the owner's name and other data as to ownership secured from deed record. These blanks will then be taken to the cemetery and a record will be made from the lots, of the names of those buried and location of grave on lot.
