John was well known for his cooking and love of eating. He had the innate ability to always find the great out-of-the-way restaurants through all his travels.

On June 24, 1956, John and Marilyn Ann Pedersen were united in marriage at Hardy, Nebraska. To this union was born, Barry Wayne, Lorraine "Lorri" Kaye and John Patrick "Pat". This union was later dissolved.

On August 29, 1978, John married Mary Jayne (Eipperle) Stepanek, they made their home in rural Essex, lowa. They enjoyed searching the countryside hoping to find old forgotten treasures and give them purpose again. He gained four daughters with this union, Dixie, Kim, Diana and Stephanie.
