**Obituary**

Eugene Paul Nesmith, son of Henry Thomas and Helena (Mungen) Nesmith, was born on October 3, 1924, in Shenandoah, Iowa and passed away Wednesday, May 10, 2000, at the Immanuel Medical Center in Omaha, Nebraska. He was 75 years of age. He spent his early childhood in Shenandoah and excelled in swimming and diving at the municipal pool in Shenandoah.

At the Shenandoah High School he concentrated on basketball where he excelled and played against the Harlem Globetrotters. Eugene graduated with the Shenandoah High School Class of 1941. He joined the U. S. Army Air Corp on December 23, 1944, and was discharged on October 9, 1945. On January 30, 1948, he was united in marriage to Jean Davis in Tarkio, Mo. Gene was employed as a brick mason for over 40 years in Shenandoah and Omaha, Nebraska, retiring in 1983. He was a member of the Veteran's of Foreign Wars Organization.

He was preceded in death by his wife Jean, an infant daughter and son, Michael, a brother Henry Thomas Nesmith, Jr., and a sister Margaret Norman. He is survived by a son, William H. Nesmith, a daughter, Janet L. Nesmith, a son-in-law, James A. Brown, five grandchildren, one great-grandchild, and other relatives and friends.
