Florence Barbara Biggers, daughter of Ernest and Florence Elizabeth (Noakes) Stirk, was born on November 15, 1928 in Shenandoah, Iowa. She entered into rest on September 20, 2014 at the Bryan Health Medical Center in Lincoln, Nebraska at the age of 85.

Barbara's early life was spent growing up in Clarinda, Iowa, where she attended school until her sophomore year, when the family moved to Belle Fourche, South Dakota. Following graduation, she moved back to Clarinda where she worked as a telephone operator.

On April 27, 1947, Barbara was united in marriage to the love of her

life, Donal A. Biggers in Clarinda. Following their marriage they resided in Atlantic, Iowa where their two boys were born, David and Ronald. They would later make moves to Emporia, KS, Falls City, NE and finally back to southwest Iowa to Shenandoah in 1959 where Donal managed Brown Shoe Fit stores in each of those communities before accepting a position in the home office.


