

## Obituary

Del N. McMannama, daughter of Albert and Mildred (Asher) Nordholm, was born on July 1, 1912, in Blanchard, Iowa, and passed away May 26, 2000, at Shenandoah Memorial Hospital in Shenandoah, Iowa. She was 87 years of age. Del graduated from the Blanchard High School as Class Valedictorian in 1930. She attended Stephens College in Columbia, Missouri. On June 21, 1936, she was united in marriage to John W. (Mac) McMannama in Blanchard.
