He was a Scoutmaster with the Boy Scouts of America with Jerry and Jeff when he took them to Philmont Scout Ranch in New Mexico. This is the same trip John had made as a Boy Scout himself. In 2016, John and Linda were honored to be a part of The Honor Flight for Veterans to Washington D.C. to tour many of the War Memorials. John was an avid sports fan and really enjoyed watching the Minnesota Vikings with LuAnn. LuAnn was also honored to present John with a "Quilt of Valor" for his service from the Shenandoah American Legion Auxiliary. He also enjoyed participating in Southwest Iowa Theater Group, he along with Lorraine and LuAnn received the Outstanding Service Award.

John and Lorraine made many trips to visit their children, grandchildren, and then their great-grand children. They also made many trips to Florida before moving there in 2002.

He was a member of the Guiding Light Community Church, Fort Myers, Florida, American Legion Posts in both Slayton and Morris Minnesota and the American Legion Post and Color Guard in Shenandoah Iowa. In 2012, John was very proud to receive his 50 year membership certificate with the American Legion.
