Coming from a family with eight children, she was used to having family around and enjoyed the summer stays and visits from all of them, where many memories were made and laughter shared.

Preceding Marilyn in death were her parents; her husband, James R (Budd) Turnbull in 2001; brothers, John Connell and wife Virginia Connell, Patrick Connell and wife Wanda Connell and Charles (Chick) Connell and wife Lou Connell; sister, Kathleen Connell Beilman and husband Robert Beilman; brother-in-law, Dale Castle and Wayne (Marlene) Graham; sister-in-law, Dolores (Donald) Connell; two nieces, Cindy Connell Swain and Jennifer Connell Olson; and nephew, Mark Connell.


