Leland Ross Nicholls, son of Ival R. and Hazel H. (Salmon) Nicholls was born on March 8, 1916, in New Hampton, Missouri. He spent his early life in Harrison County, Missouri. Leland served in the Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC) from 1933 - 1938 in Northern Missouri.
