dwell in the house of the Lord forever.*

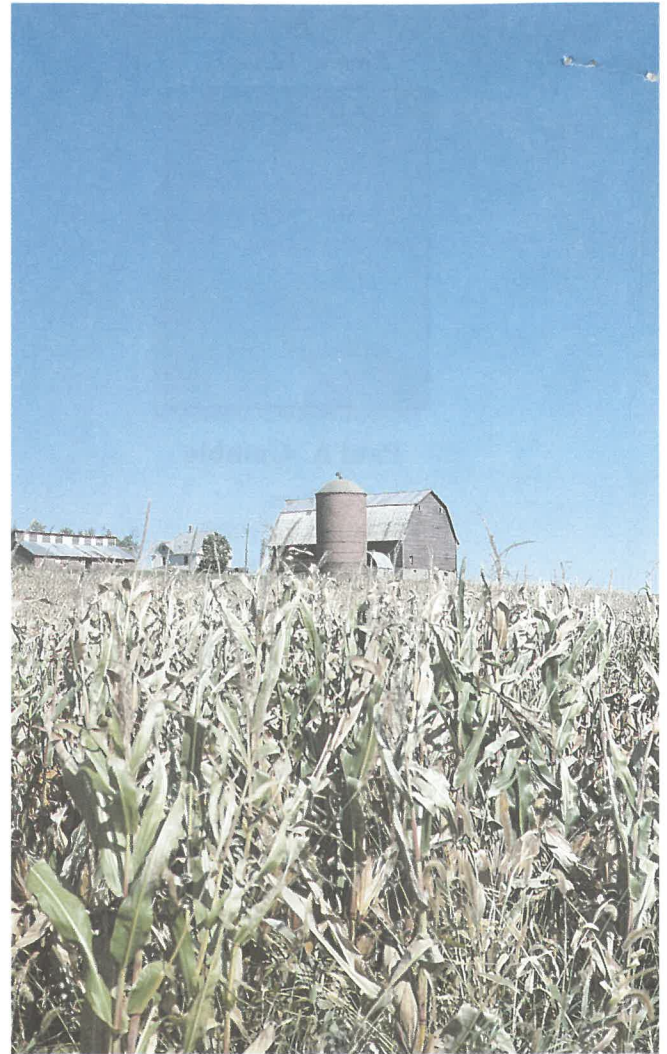
Paul A. Gamble
