1911 - 2003

Ople Frederic Miller, son of Fred and Anna (Sanders) Miller, was born on September 16, 1911, in Sidney, Iowa. "Opie" passed away on February 17, 2003, in Shenandoah, Iowa, at Garden View Care Center, where he had been a resident. He was 91 years of age. Opie grew up in the Anderson and Sidney, Iowa, area and was educated in the schools there. He later moved to Shenandoah where he spent the rest of his life. In 1936, Opie was united in marriage to Ruby Marie Hall. He worked 17 years for the Lakes Nurseries in Shenandoah before working for Iowa Power & Light for 24 years on the substation, line and gas crews. Following his retirement he helped set stones for John Leacox Monument Co. and later for Hackett Monument Co.

Preceding Opie in death were his parents and wife Ruby. Survivors include his daughter, Mary Pierce and her husband Elroy and son, Larry Miller, all of Shenandoah, Iowa; six grandchildren; one sister, Eva Spitsnogle of Hemet, California; other relatives and friends.
