When she was no longer able to attend the group quilting, she continued to piece quilt tops for mission service. She enjoyed reading, crocheting, piecing quilts, working crossword and jigsaw puzzles, cooking and collecting recipes. She derived great pleasure in sharing her talents with family and friends, many of whom use and enjoy the results of her crochet hook. She was an excellent cook and loved to prepare "treats" for her grandchildren. She was very independent and sought never to "impose" upon others.

Preceding Vivian in death were her parents; sister, Mildred; and husband Paul in 2000.
