Growing up on a farm near Imogene, Iowa, Doris graduated from Shenandoah High School in 1935. She also graduated from Peru State Teachers College in Peru, Nebraska and went on to teach school for about ten years in Tabor, Malvern, Council Bluffs, and Anderson, Iowa. She enjoyed teaching and interacting with children.

On February 8, 1948, Doris was united in marriage to Wayne Lorimor and to this union three children, Larry, Gary, and Don were born. After their marriage they lived for over fifty years on the family farm where they raised their children, and where she presently was living.
