Field Record of Previous Burials

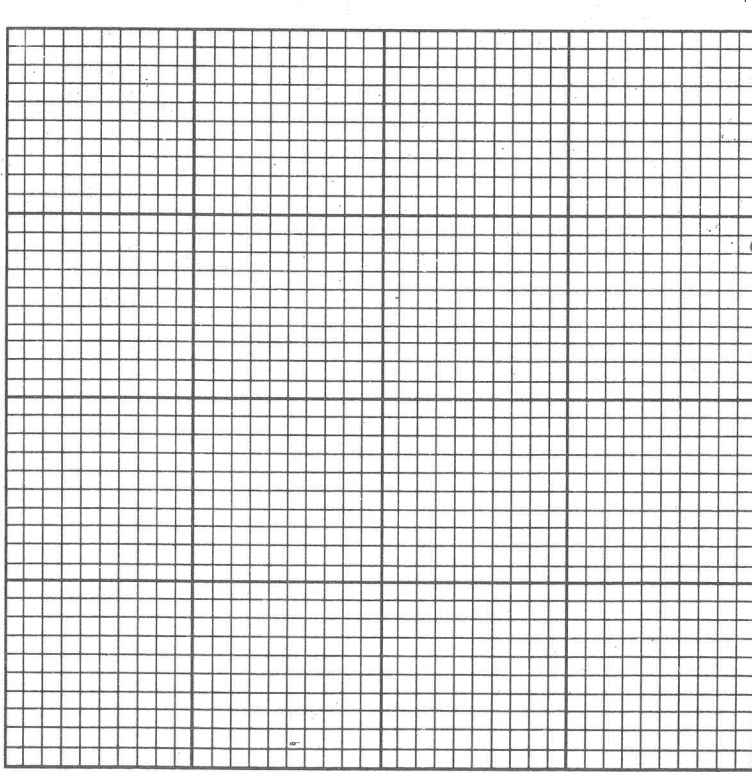
