Marvin Alfred Warnemunde, the son of Henry and Dora (Hood) Warnemunde, was born March 7, 1920, in Winside, Nebraska, and departed this life on April 9, 2000 at Stanton Care Center, in Stanton, Iowa.

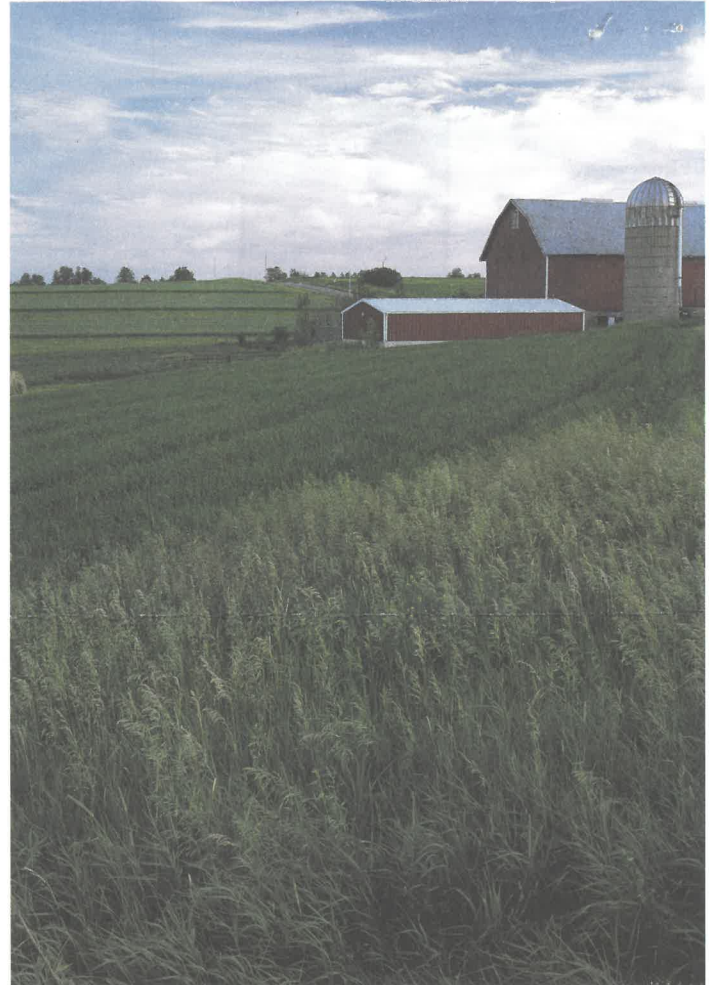
Marvin grew up in Winside, Nebraska and received his education in the Winside School System. During World War II, Marvin served his country in the United States Army from 1942 until 1945. He participated in the European theater. Some of his battle arenas were Sicily, Naples, Foggia, Rome and Germany. His medals include the European-African-Middle Eastern Theater Service Medal with four overseas bars and the Good Conduct Medal with Bronze Arrowhead.

Marvin married Ethel Mae Lawrence on November 23, 1942 at Riverside, CA and to this union four children, Kathryn, Nancy, Gregory, and Robert were born. On June 7, 1985, Marvin married Helen LaFollette at Ft. Worth, Texas. Marvin was known for his knowledge of seed corn. He worked as a seed corn salesman for many years working for Henry Field, Earl May, and Lynks. After retirement from Lynks, he sold for the Curry Seed Corn Company part-time. At one time in his working career he was also an auctioneer. He was a member of the First Christian Church and the American Legion Post #888 in Shenandoah.

Preceding Marvin in death were his parents and his wife, Ethel in 1985, and his wife, Helen, in 1995.
