George Alfred Carrol Johnson, age 93, the son of Carl Alfred Clarence. and Alice (Maxwell) Johnson was born August 13, 1913, at Essex, Iowa, and passed away September 7, 2006, in Shenandoah, Iowa.

Growing up in the rural Shenandoah and Essex areas Carrol received his education at Mt. Vernon country school for his first 4 years, then Pleasant Hill country school through the eighth grade. He then attended and graduated from Shenandoah High School. After his marriage to Ardella Tripp, they lived and farmed between Shenandoah and Essex for many years. They also milked cows and fed calves. Through the years Carrol worked part time for various local businesses including Farmers Coop, Henry Fields and Cambier Chevrolet.

Carrol was known to be hard working and taught his sons the value of having good work ethics. He enjoyed farming, watching cattle graze, clean fields of soybeans and good tight fences.

For many years Carrol was a member of St. Johns Lutheran Church in Essex and more recently attended Memorial Baptist Church in Shenandoah.

Preceding Carrol in death were his parents; a son, James A. Johnson; wife, Ardella; sister Marvis Stephens; and great granddaughter, Justice Johnson.
