## Arvid Sandahl

Arvid E. Sandahl, the son of Emil and Hulda (Klaung) Sandahl, was born February 20, 1914, in rural Shenandoah, IA and departed this life on March 4, 2000, at his home in rural Shenandoah.

Arvid grew up in Page County Iowa and received his education from the Center Country School.
