

Hazel Wax, age 84, of Shenandoah, Iowa passed away Sunday, July 21, 2002 at the Gardenview Care Center in Shenandoah, Iowa after an extended illness. Hazel Margaret Wax was born January 20, 1918 near Imogene, Iowa the daughter of James and Leah (Perkins) Nicholas. Hazel was the oldest of five children. She attended country school at the Gulf School in Page County for 2 years, and then went to Shady Dell School for 6 years before transferring to Imogene Public Schools where she graduated in 1935. She attended Nurses Training at the

Hand Hospital in Shenandoah. Hazel was a general duty and private duty nurse for 6 years, two of those being in Chicago just before she came back to Imogene in 1945. On December 20, 1945 she was united in marriage to Cecille Wax in Hiawatha, Kansas. They began farming right after their marriage, moving to Emerson in 1951. In 1972, they quit farming and later moved to Shenandoah, Iowa where Hazel continued to do private nursing. She was a member of the United Methodist Church in Shenandoah; Past President of the American Legion Auxiliary in Emerson; and was Past President of the Emerson United Methodist Women. She also taught Sunday School and Bible School.

Hazel was preceded in death by her parents; 2 sisters: Gladys Harris and Evelyn Hall; and a brother: Thomas Nicholas.
