Paul Edward Jones, the son of Gerney C. and Mabel C. (Brown) Jones, was born June 18, 1921 in Shenandoah, Iowa, and passed away November 27, 2002, also in Shenandoah.

Growing up in Shenandoah, Paul received his education from the Shenandoah schools, graduating from high school in 1940. On June 8, 1941, Paul was united in marriage to Evelyn M. Thomas and they were married for 61 years. To this union, six children, Margo Sherry, Paul, Jr., Greg, Andrea, Danne and Gary were born.

In 1942, Paul served in the Air Corps Glider School; training in Tarkio, Missouri, and soon after, continued his service to his country in the U.S. Army Infantry. He was awarded a Purple Heart with oak leaf cluster for his service in the Pacific during World War II. After his tour of duty, Paul attended watch-making school in Kansas City, Missouri and eventually, ran the Modern Jewelry Store in Shenandoah. For most of Paul's working years, he traveled for FBI Gordon as Director of Sales. Due to poor health, he was forced to retire in 1993.

Paul enjoyed remodeling and refurbishing his rental properties, but most of all he enjoyed being with his family and looked forward to those special occasions when they could all get together. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign War, American Legion Post #88 and Saint John's Episcopal Church. He was also a former member of Shenandoah Elks 1122, Lions Club, Rotary Club and Junior Chamber of Commerce.

Preceding Paul in death were his parents; son, Paul Jr., stepfather, Carl Seig; sister, Ellen Reavis; brother, Raymond Jones; granddaughters, Kelly Jones; and great grandson, Kyle Bryant.
