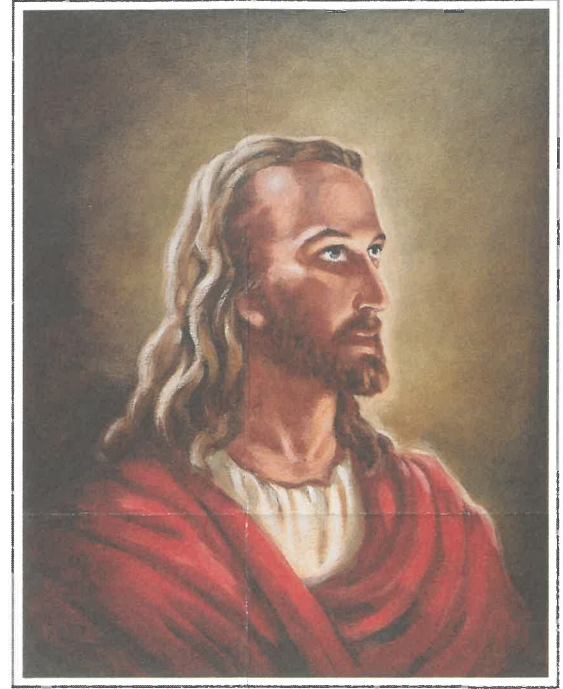
She was united in marriage to Charles J. "Chick" Connell on April 10, 1950 at Shenandoah, IA.
