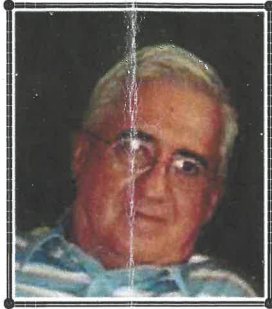


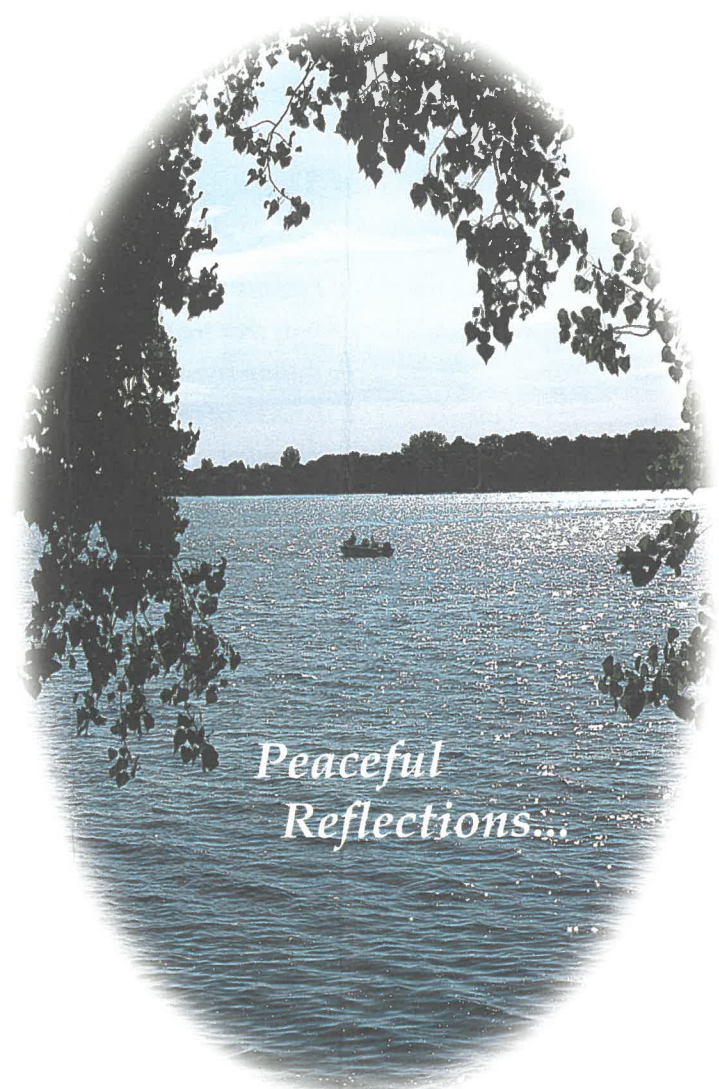
## William C. "Bill" Moser
