Lord forever.*

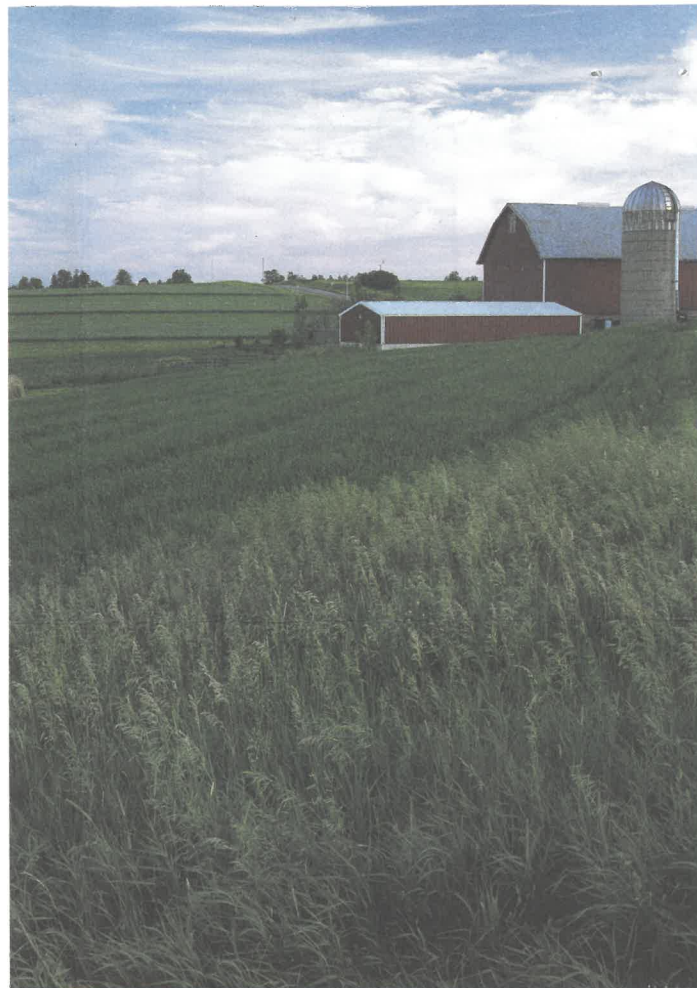
Samuel E. Boatwright
