## Theodore Knight

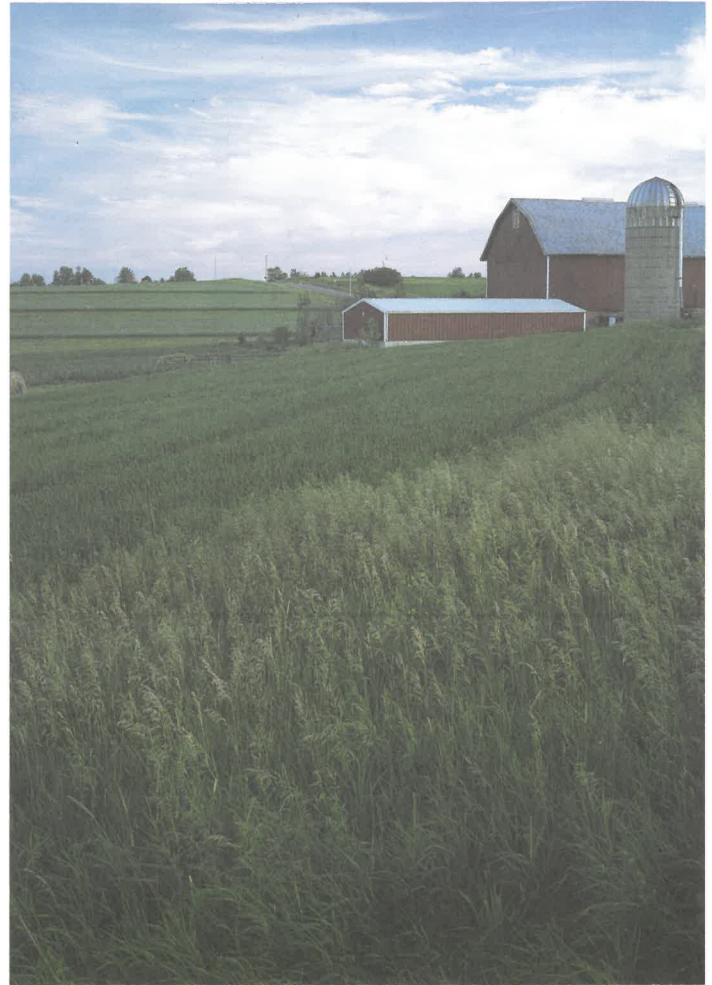
